WHODrug Koda is UMC's brand new virtual drug coding assistant, designed to help WHODrug coders and reviewers in achieving consistent and efficient coding of concomitant medications. WHODrug Koda is available via an online application and can also be connected to your coding application via a dedicated API service, resulting in a seamless integration in your existing workflow. The following software systems and related vendors within the WHODrug Vendor Programme have recently announced compatibility with the WHODrug Koda API:

- cubeCDMS, CRScube Inc (since June 27, 2019).
- Eclipse Coding, Eclipse Enterprise Solutions, LLC (from Eclipse Coding version 2.5.1.).
- MedCodr, Prudentia Group LLC (planned for Q2 for an early Q3 release with release of next version of MedCodr).

The WHODrug Global dictionary data has for long been available as fixed width text files encoded in ASCII.

From the September 2019 release, WHODrug Global will also be available in .csv format (encoded in UTF-8, with full Unicode support). Sample files can be delivered upon request.

WHODrug Global Chinese is also available as both fixed width text files and in .csv format. Both types are encoded in UTF-8 and offer full Unicode support.
